1. 1964 / Chisholm = early edu. expert from NYC / elected U.S. House of Rep.
In 1964, Chisholm, an early education expert from New York City, was elected to the United States House of Representatives.
2. Chisholm = 1st Black woman run for pres. / blocked from debates -> sued **Chisholm, the first Black woman to run for president, was blocked from the debates, so she sued.**
3. during 14 yrs. House of Rep. / fought for equal rights / women, minorities, + poor
During the 14 years she served on the House of Representatives, she fought for equal rights for women, minorities, and the poor.
4. Chisholm / remembered as brave + outspoken
Chisholm will always be remembered as being brave and outspoken.
